did you know...?

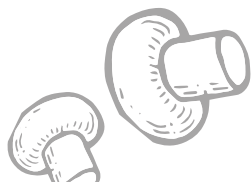
On average, Italians eat 25 kg of pasta and drink almost 100 litres of wine a year.

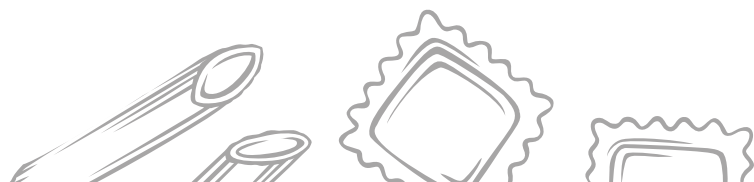

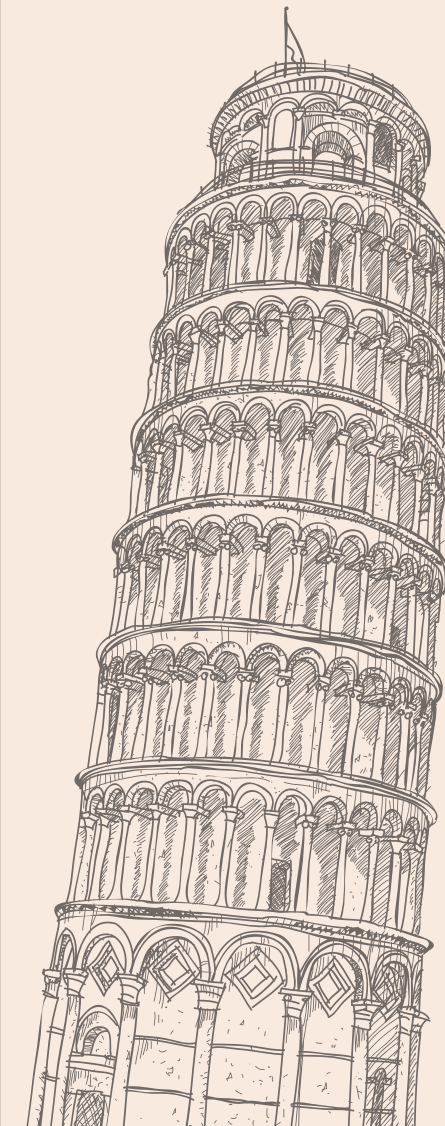

did you know...?

The Antica Pizzeria Port'Alba in Naples, Italy, is considered to be the world's first pizzeria, where it was sold as early as 1738. According to popular urban legend, pizza was invented by Raffaele Esposito in 1889 in honour of Queen Margherita, which he called margherita pizza. Historians recall, however, that street vendors in Naples had been selling such pastries with toppings for many years before that. The most likely ancestor of pizza is thought to be focaccia.

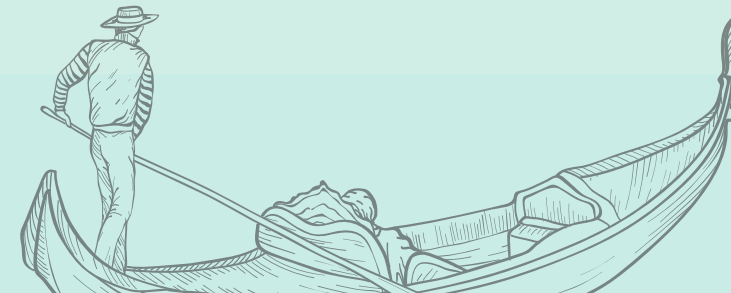
